You may register to vote or make changes to your current registration at the polls on Election Day. However, the law requires that you show ID for registration. The easiest way is to bring your valid WY Driver's License to the polls. If you do not have a valid WY Driver's License, please take another type of photo ID with you (in this case, you will also have to provide the last four (4) digits of your Social Security number). If you do not have a photo ID, please call our office for further options.

Absentee ballots are available in the County Clerk's Office at 925 Sage Avenue, Suite 101, Kemmerer, through November 5th (NOT on Election Day) if you wish to vote by absentee. Ballots may be requested over the phone or in person. If requesting a ballot for someone else, we must mail the ballot to the voter or you may bring a note signed by the voter giving you permission to pick up a ballot for them. You may take your ballot or vote in the office. Absentee ballots must be returned to the County Clerk's Office no later than 7:00 p.m. on Election Day, November 6, 2018, to be counted.
