

## NO BAKE PUMPKIN CHEESECAKE BARS

#### INGREDIENTS

#### GRAHAM CRACKER CRUST

- 2 sleeves (18 sheets) graham crackers (approximately 2 cups of crumbs)
- 2 tablespoons white granulated sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1 cup salted butter, melted

#### PUMPKIN CHEESECAKE FILLING

- 2 (80z) bricks of cream cheese, softened
- 1 cup powdered sugar
- 1/4 cup packed brown sugar
- 1 cup pumpkin puree
- 21/4 teaspoons pumpkin pie spice
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 (120z) container whipped topping, thawed



#### INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Add the graham crackers to the bowl of a food processor. Add 2 tablespoons of sugar and 1/2 teaspoon of ground cinnamon. Process on high speed until the crackers and fully broken down into fine crumbs. Alternately, you can whisk together 2 cups of store bought graham cracker crumbs with the cinnamon and sugar.
- Pour the graham cracker crumbs into a medium sized bowl. Add the melted butter and stir together with a rubber spatula.
- 3. Once the graham cracker crumbs are fully saturated in the melted butter, add them to a 9X13 glass baking dish.
- 4. Use the rubber spatula or your fingers to press the crushed graham crackers into the bottom of the glass pan. Pack the crumbs into a firm base layer.
- 5. Place the baking dish in the fridge and chill for 15 minutes while you prepare the pumpkin cheesecake filling.
- 6. Add the two bricks of softened cream cheese to a large mixing bowl.
- 7. Add the brown sugar, powdered sugar, pumpkin pie spice, pumpkin puree, and vanilla extract to the cream cheese.
- 8. Beat with a hand blender until creamy and smooth.
- Add the thawed whipped topping to the bowl, and mix on low speed until fully combined and fluffy.
- 10. Remove the chilled graham cracker base from the fridge, and add the cheesecake filling on top. Spread it out evenly with a silicone spatula.
- 11. Cover tightly with plastic wrap and place in the fridge. Chill until set, for a minimum of 4 hours. 8-12 hours is best.
